



## GREAT FOSTERS

BUILT AS A ROYAL HUNTING LODGE 1550 AD

At the Great Fosters guests are accommodated in three separate buildings. The Main House, which dates from 1550, offers a choice of historic suites and bedrooms. The Cloisters and The Coach House are a short walk across the courtyard and offer contemporary décor whilst still retaining Great Fosters' elegant atmosphere. The bedrooms and junior suites offer comfortable seating, plasma screens, Bose iPod docking stations, laptop safes and mini bars. All bedrooms throughout the hotel feature beds made with silk filled duvets and all have complimentary Wi-Fi.

### The Main House

#### **Standard Double Rooms**

These quaint bedrooms are located on the 2<sup>nd</sup> Floor of The Main House. Some rooms overlook the gardens, whilst others look over the front of the house. All rooms have either a shower over the bath, or a shower only. Rooms are between 15-20m<sup>2</sup>.

#### **Superior Double Rooms**

These rooms offer a breathtaking view of the topiary garden and Japanese bridge. Each is uniquely decorated and has a work desk and easy chair. All rooms have en-suite bathrooms with a shower over the bath. Rooms have either a 5ft double or 6ft king size bed, which can be converted to twin beds if required. Rooms are between 16 and 20m<sup>2</sup>.

#### **Executive Double Rooms**

Executive bedrooms are individually decorated in keeping with the Jacobean theme. They have a separate dressing area to the main bedroom and 6ft king-size beds, which can be converted to twin beds. All rooms have en-suite bathrooms with a shower over the bath. They are between 25 - 33m<sup>2</sup>.

#### **Premier Executive Double Rooms**

Although in keeping with the theme of the Main House, these bedrooms have contemporary décor and modern amenities. The rooms either have a view over the front of the hotel or the gardens. They have flat screen televisions, in-room safes and a Bose iPod docking station. All rooms have 6ft king-size beds, which can be converted to twin beds, a work desk and easy chairs. Bathrooms have a shower over the bath, with one room having a separate shower. Bedrooms are between 23 - 29m<sup>2</sup>.

#### **Historic Rooms**

This collection of rooms has been individually decorated to add to the elegance of the hotel. Whether it's ornate Italian furniture, sixteenth century tapestries or a luxurious four-poster bed, these spacious rooms and suites complement the grandeur of the house. Bedrooms vary in size from 50 - 70m<sup>2</sup>

## **The Cloisters**

The Cloisters are reached via a short walk across a courtyard and are an elegant collection of 3 junior suites and 8 double rooms overlooking an intimate Cloister style garden. They offer excellent facilities and combine the charming historical features of the Main House with contemporary décor. The double rooms have 5ft king-size double beds, mini bar, Bose iPod docking stations and flat screen televisions.

The junior suites have 6ft super king-size beds and luxurious sofas. All rooms are on the ground floor and have en-suite bathrooms with a shower over the bath. One double room has been designed for disabled use.

The double rooms are 16-18m<sup>2</sup> whilst the junior suites are approx 30m<sup>2</sup>.

## **The Coach House**

The Coach House, a short walk across the courtyard from the Main House, was completely refurbished in 2008 to create 11 beautiful junior suites and double rooms. Some bathrooms have separate showers whilst another has its own steam room.

The junior suites are 16-20 m<sup>2</sup> and all have bathrooms with a bath and separate shower.

The premier double rooms are 15-20m<sup>2</sup>. Some rooms have a bathroom with a bath and a separate shower whilst others have a shower over the bath.

The smaller double rooms are 9-12 m<sup>2</sup> and either have a bath with shower or a shower only.
